

More that 30% of the registry population have a history of P. aeruginosa.





Some interesting data covered in the meeting; Over 60% of patients in the registry receive a long acting bronchodilator and almost as many are in receipt of an inhaled corticosteroid.

Around 40% of the cohort receive/have received physiotherapy, however very few (<10%) receive/perform any other type of airway clearance.
